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<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>2</sup> Facilities that meet the definition of "secondary activities farms" except for the ownership criterion can take advantage of an extension for compliance with the PC rule if: (1) The operation is not located on the primary production farm; (2) The operation is devoted to harvesting, packing, and/or holding of RACs (including operations that hull, shell, and/or dry nuts without additional manufacturing); and (3) The operation is under common ownership with the primary production farm that grows, harvests, and/or raises the majority of the RACs harvested, packed, and/or held by the operation.

<sup>&</sup>lt;sup>3</sup> Provisions with extended compliance dates include: (1) The specific microbiological criteria that apply to agricultural water; (2) Corrective measures that must be taken if agricultural water does not meet requirements; (3) The frequency of testing agricultural water; and (4) Records associated with data to support a microbial die-off rate, corrective measures, test results from a public water system, or data used to support alternative die-off rates, criteria, or sampling strategies.
